Dear Mrs. Winter,

I was greatly encouraged by your willingness to come to Baltimore to participate in the first "Perspectives" Study Program in this area. You were highly recommended by Fran Patt, who spoke with you regarding your trip to Baltimore after your lecture in Philadelphia. I am writing to confirm the date and provide the details you will need.

On March 5, 1986, you will have two 45 minute periods to lecture. We will begin at 7:00 pm and end at 9:45 pm. Following your second lecture period, 15 minutes have been set aside for the students to ask questions. Class will be held at Roland Park Country School, where Grace Fellowship Church meets.

We would like you to present an overview of what has happened in world evangelization since the first century A.D. You will be introducing the historical section of the course. The students will be reading lesson 5, of the study guide, following your lecture. Special emphasis will be given to Carey, Taylor, and Townsend the week following your lecture. Please return the enclosed notetaking outline and faculty description sheet and we will take care of duplicating them.

We would also like you to take part in a woman's luncheon sponsored by Grace Fellowship Church the day of class. This would be an opportunity to address issues pertaining to lifestyle, with leading women in the church and the leader's wives. Please contact us if you are open to this.

We are expecting 50 students, primarily post-college members of local churches. A large percentage of the students will be from Grace Fellowship Church. Most of the participants are actively pursuing to possibility of serving Christ overseas. There will be several missions committee members from various churches.

As Fran discussed with you, we will cover your travel expenses and provide an honorarium of \$75.00. We will take care of your arrangements getting to and around Baltimore. You will be staying with my wife and I, Wednesday night.
