The Model 100 SIG is intended for the users of the TRS-80 Model 100. Our purpose is to share knowledge, experiences, programs, and product information with each other so that we may mutually gain from the SIG. There are no membership dues or payments in addition to CompuServe's connect charges. In order to become a member, simply choose option 2 from the "New member menu:" and you will become a member immediately after responding with your name; please use

first and last name.

There are currently ten topics on the Message Board and a matching ten Databases [DL]. The Databases contain 1000 + files of interest to Model 100 users. The vast majority of the files are public domain software that is Model 100 specific. There are programs for businessmen, housewives, children, travellers, aviators, and a wealth of programs for programmers. There are many textual files that: (1) explain SIG usage, (2) discuss technical points, or (3) contain product descriptions/reviews. The DL9 file has an index of all the files in the database; it is about 20+ pages to ECHO or a 36K+ download. See INDEX.HLP in DL9 for alternative means of getting the information. Also see CATLOG.CAT in DL9 for list and description of catalog files in

each of the databases.

If you do not understand what to do next at a prompt, you may type ? <ENTER> or HELP <ENTER> and guidance will usually be given. If you do not understand a command, type ? cmd <ENTER> where cmd=option you wish explained: Example:

? L <ENTER> at the next prompt will give you an explanation of the <L>eave command on the message board.

For more information, type "B;2" at the next prompt for ulletin.

Database DLO has various Helpers that may ease your way and save \$\$\$.

At DL 0: prompt use S *.HLP for a listing of the help files. The X0 file has a brief helper on how to download, or copy, a file from the DL databases. At Function menu prompt, which is the next prompt following, type X0 & <ENTER>.

Short descriptions of each DL,

and their catalog files, may be commanded from the Function menu by

use of "Xn" commands. Example:

X4 <ENTER> at Function menu will transmit description of DL4 and list the catalog files for it.

Members of this SIG are known for their friendliness & help for each other and the newcomer. Just ask and you are likely to have the answer by the time the evening is over. Your need to ask is reduced, however, if you read the entire ulletin list and the X0, X1, X2 ... X9 files.

Members are asked to use their first and last name. That is for message headers, users listing, and the Users Interest file. If necessary to make a change, use OP;CN command at next prompt. Use the P command to make name change permanent.

EZSIG4 100 from database DLO.
